### What is Lent?

Lent lasts for 40 days (not including Sundays) to symbolise Jesus being tempted by the Devil in the desert, where he fasted for 40 days. It is the time when we prepare for Easter by thinking of the things we have done wrong. Lent used to be a time for fasting or going without food as Jesus had done. Nowadays many people give up a favourite thing they enjoy like sweets and often give money to charity.

### Why is the Church Colour Violet/Purple?

As the Church colour is Violet/Purple, Archdeacon Kaio Karipa will wear his purple stole (right) and the altar/Eucharist will have purple coverings during Lent.

Purple is chosen for a few reasons. One, it is the colour associated with mourning and so it helps us

think about the sadness of Jesus' death. Another reason is the Bible tells us that Pilate and his soldiers placed a purple robe on Jesus, just before His crucifixion (Mark 15:16-20). The other reason is that purple is the colour linked to royalty and so it celebrates Christ's coming as a King (Advent).
